

Using Release Conditions to Limit Who Sees an Assignment or Announcement

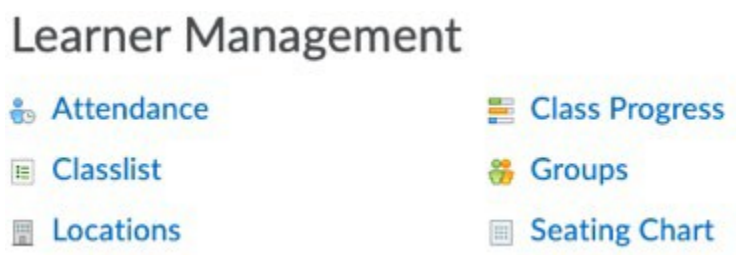
You can skip to Step 2 if your groups are already set up.

This is primarily for creating unique assignments for IPP kids that only they can see. Also generally how to limit access to any of your D2L assignments or announcements.

Step 1: Creating Custom Groups

Said group can have one student or many students – it doesn't matter.

1. Go to Groups in Course Administration



2. Click – New Category

Pretty self explanatory – but some additional tips (all customizable)

- a. Call the new category something benign like 'Differentiation',
- b. select "# of Groups – No Auto Enrolments",
- c. The number of groups should be minimum 2 IMO
- d. do not make groups descriptions visible.

Step 2: Creating a conditional Release for an item

This can be done for any new item – content, announcement, assignment etc.

1. Make a new item of any type – I am going to make a new folder in Assignments

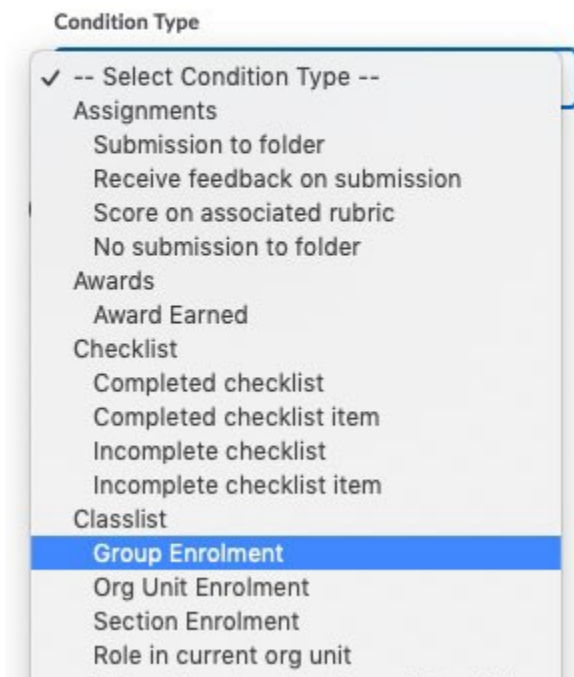

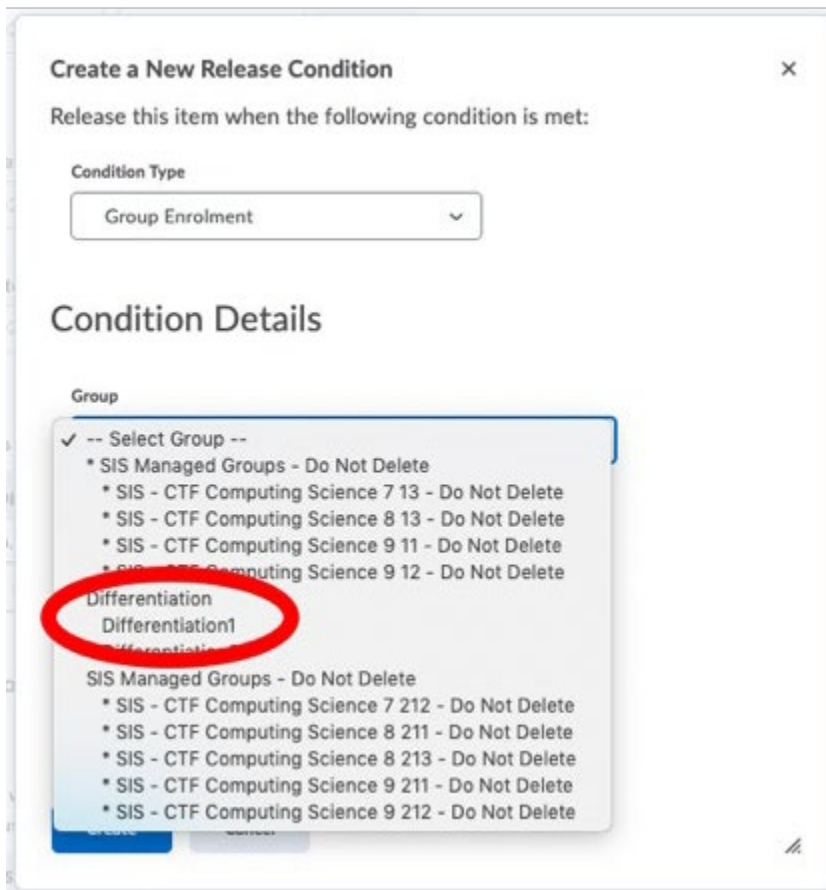

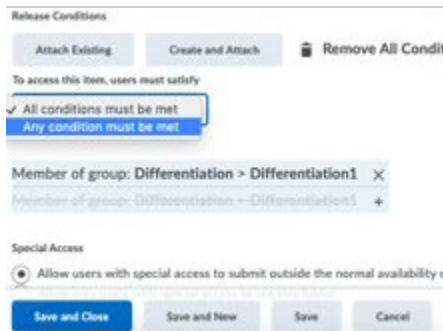

5. A new dropdown will appear. Choose the group you want this item visible for (I chose Differentiation1)

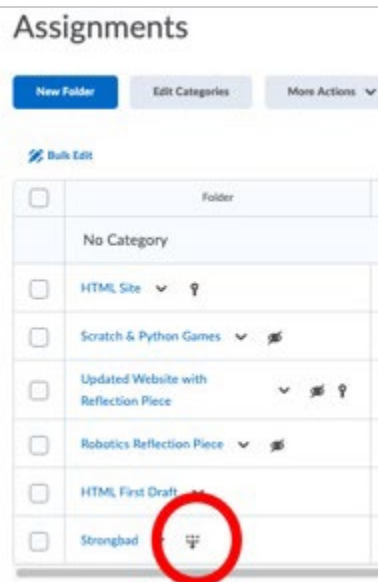


6. I then prefer to change a setting to 'Any condition must be met' and save. This is optional.

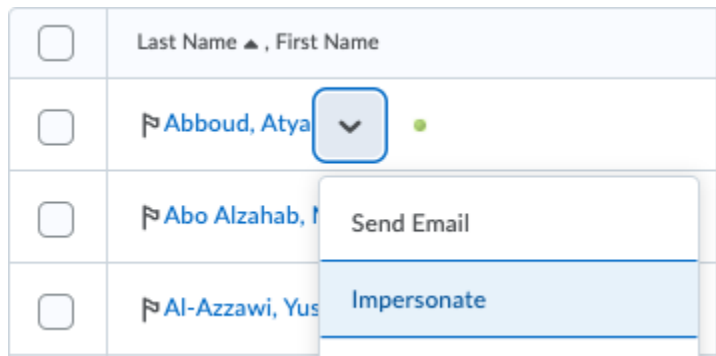


You are all done now but the first couple of times you do this you will want to verify that it worked
